Security High Priority for New GroupDrive 3.0

New Version Adds QuickLinks and Increases Security

Annapolis, MD - February 8, 2005 – South River Technologies announced today the release of version 3.0 of their GroupDrive File Collaboration Suite. GroupDrive gives users a simple solution to collaborate on files securely over the Internet. Documents are stored in a central location, ensuring that users have the most current version and eliminating manual integrating of edits from multiple content contributors.

The new version adds QuickLinks which offer an efficient alternative to emailing file attachments. QuickLinks are shortcuts to files or folders with the ability to grant read or write permissions to a file, set an expiration date to a link or limit the number of accesses.

Certificate support is another new feature adding to the security of GroupDrive. Certificates allow the host server to verify the integrity of the accessing party, protecting the server from unauthorized users. This can be used in addition to the secure transmission capability already supported over SSL.

GroupDrive has expanded its interface by adding multiple browser support. In addition to supporting Internet Explorer 5.5, GroupDrive now supports the Firefox and Netscape browsers on the Windows, MAC and Linux platforms.
