South River Technologies Implements New Technology in WebDrive® 7.0 Release

New Backup and Streaming Features Enhance Customer Experience

Annapolis, MD – December 13, 2005 – The pioneers of Internet drive mapping technology, South River Technologies (SRT) today announced the release of WebDrive version 7.0. WebDrive lets users access, edit and share files on their web server without the additional download and upload steps.

The new WebDrive version includes streaming, making it the only remote access client that maps a drive to servers on the Internet and streams A/V files to the desktop. With a simple double click of a file, users can play large videos or MP3 files within seconds, making the performance similar to opening a file on the user's PC.

Another valuable addition is WebDrive's new synchronization feature that allows offline work to become more useful. Users work offline on files and folders and can sync up live once they re-connect. Synchronization can also be run on a scheduled basis.

WebDrive now includes a File Transfer Manager enabling the user to easily backup files and folders. Backups can be scheduled to run on a regular basis and full or incremental backups are supported.

"These new features specifically address requirements of our OEM partners and our enterprise customers," says Tracy Welsh, VP of Business Development for SRT. "The need for simple backup and synchronization continues to grow, and the ease of doing that through a mapped drive letter is very attractive for our customers and partners."
